
GENOCIDES FORMALLY RECOGNIZED BY THE GOVERMENT OF CANADA

- The Holodomor (Ukraine) (1932–1933)
 The Holocaust (1933–1945)
- The Rwandan Genocide (1994)
- The ethnic cleansing in Bosnia (1995)
- The cultural genocide of Indigenous Peoples in Canada (1870 1996)

Disclaimer: The dates of many of these genocides are still debated among genocide experts.

Note: There are other serious, violent crimes that do not fall under the specific definition of genocide, for example, crimes against humanity, war crimes, ethnic cleansing. This does not make them any less devastating or serious in nature. Many debate whether other cases fall under the definition of genocide, for example, the Rohingya in Myanmar & the Uyghurs in China.
